GENERAL RULES

- 1. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed.
- 2. RPM limits vary by class. Please, see individual class rules for limits.
- 3. All tractor classes are limited to a single turbo.
- 4. All minors must have written consent of parent or guardian and must be at least 17 years of age to pull.
- 5. All entries must be made at the judges stand at least one half-hour (½) before the class starts.
- 6. Only two (2) drivers allowed per tractor/truck and drivers must remain seated while pulling and retain one (1) hand on the steering wheel at all times.
- 7. All classes will have a floating finish.
- 8. Pull with begin with a tight chain.
- 9. Tractors/Trucks are limited to one (1) place pay-out, highest finish will be paid.
- 10. Clevis/Hitch must have a minimum 3½ inch opening.
- 11. The first driver in each class has the option to drop to the third position.
- 12. At the conclusion of each individual's pull, they shall cross the scales for an official weight. Scales will be located at the pull site. An optional weigh-in for each tractor will be allowed prior to each entry in each class, but will not be consider an official weight.
- 13. All tractor/trucks must be in neutral or park while being hooked to or unhooked from the sled.

- 14. Any part of the tractor/truck that comes off and falls to the ground, or has excessive fluid loss while hooked to the sled, will be automatically disqualified.
- 15. Pulling positions will be determined by draw before each class starts.
- 16. Tractors must maintain stock appearance.
- 17. Stationary draw bar is to be 20 inches or less without weight transfer or hydraulic assist.
- 18. Hitch point must measure a minimum 18 inches from center of the rear axle.
- 19. Exhaust must exit upward and all tractors with turbos and no muffler must have cross bolts in the straight pipe. If curved pipe, must point straight forward.
- If 4-wheel (MFWD or HFWD) drive tractors are to pull, they must drop front drive shaft or show judges that the switch is secured so the front wheels cannot be engaged.
- 21. If any weights are hung on the three (3) point hitch, hitch must stay in the up position and not interfere with hooking and unhooking.
- 22. Safety is very important!
- 23. Judges' decisions are final. Judges' have the right to stop and/or disqualify any contestant if a tractor/truck is being operated in an unsafe manner or if cheating is suspected.
